**SRO** (1979/82) In pursuance of Sub-rule (2) of rule 3 of the Civil Servants (Appointment, Promotion and Transfer) Rules, 1973, the following methods, qualifications and other conditions are laid down for appointment to the posts of Surveyor General of Pakistan (Grade-21) and Deputy Surveyor General (Grade-20) in Survey of Pakistan, Ministry of Defence.

## I. METHOD OF APPOINTMENT

2. Recruitment to the posts covered in these rules shall be made by the following methods:-

#### II. CONDITIONS FOR PROMOTION

3. Promotion to post in column (1) below shall be made by selection from amongst the persons who hold the posts specified in column (2) on regular basis and conform to conditions of eligibility prescribed in column (3) below:-

#### III. QUALIFICATIONS/CONDITIONS FOR TRANSFER/SECONDMENT.

4. The appointment by transfer/secondment shall be made from amongst the persons holding appointment on a regular basis in the same or equivalent grade in which the post to be filled exists, provided the person concerned possesses the qualifications/experience prescribed for direct recruitment to the post concerned.

### IV. APPOINTMENT BY DIRECT RECRUITMENT

5. A candidate must possess the educational qualification, experience as mentioned against the post concerned in the Schedule to this Notification.

The maximum age limit in the case of direct recruitment will be relaxed as follows:-

- (a) By three years in respect of candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes, Budist Community, Recognized Tribes of Tribal Areas, Azad Kashmir and Northern Areas (Districts of Gilgit, Ghanchi, Skardu and Diamir) in accordance with the instructions issued by the Establishment Division.
- (b) By maximum of 10 years in case of released/retired officers of the Armed Forces or by the number of years of their service whichever is less.
- (c) By not more than 10 years upto the age of 55 years for Government Servants who have completed at least 2 years service.

#### V. PROBATION

6. Persons appointed by promotion, transfer/secondment or direct recruitment shall be on probation for a period of one year. This period may be curtailed for good and sufficient reasons to be recorded, or if considered necessary, it may be extended for a period not exceeding 1 year as may be prescribed at the time of appointment. Appointment on probation shall be subject to the provisions of section 6 of Civil Servants Act 1973.

7. This Notification issued with the approval of the Establishment Division and the F.P.S.C and supersedes the Ministry of Agriculture & Works Notification No.SRO.225(K)/68, dated 09-2-1968 (amended from time to time) to the extent of the post of Surveyor General and Deputy Surveyor General.
